The report from work supervisor and intern curator is critical in management of impairment. The health committee urges the supervisor or intern curator to provide a signed comprehensive report on official letter head, to ensure authenticity. At a minimum, the following information should be included on the report:

- 1. Personal identification details of the impaired/alleged impaired health practitioner or student (the patient), such as
 - Name.
 - Surname.
 - HPCSA's registration or ID number.
 - Place of work.
- 2. Functioning of the practitioner in relation to -
 - Personal conduct.
 - Work currently performed.
 - Recent work accomplished and any highlights.
 - Professionally and work functioning.
 - Team cohesiveness.
 - Social/recreational.
 - Work adjustment.
 - Any notable changes.
- 3. Any available collateral information from other informants, such as family or colleagues or treating health practitioner.
- 4. Recommendations from workplace perspective.
- 5. Any other necessary information for the health committee's consideration.
