
CALL FOR APPOINTMENT AS MODERATOR FOR THE PROFESSIONAL BOARD OF EMERGENCY CARE (PBEC)

Dear Stakeholders

The Professional Board for Emergency Care (PBEC) wishes to increase its existing pool of moderators. Interested candidates are therefore invited to apply to assist the PBEC with its moderation activities.

Moderators to be employed are required to comply with the below:

1. Not be employed by the Higher Education Institution (HEI) to be moderated.
2. Have active registration with the HPCSA PBEC.
3. PBEC moderators must hold a qualification at one level higher on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) than the programme being moderated. In the context of the Bachelor's degree qualification moderation, the PBEC moderator should ideally hold an NQF-Level 9/10 qualification. Alternatively, requisite academic and clinical experience in relation to the Emergency Care Practitioner registration category can be considered appropriate (to be assessed by the PBEC on an individual basis).
4. Have experience in the programme being moderated. Experience can include prior completion of the programme, lecturing/instruction and/or assessment/moderation on the programme.
5. Comply with the contents of Form 305 (Code of Conduct and Declaration of Confidentiality for Evaluators, Examiners and Moderators).

Moderators will be appointed for a period of three (3) years consecutively.
