

# HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

## REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE DISPENSING OF MEDICINES BY MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS AND DENTISTS

Published under Government Notice R1730 in *Government Gazette* 9886 of 9 August 1985.

In terms of [section 52](#) of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), the Minister of Health and Welfare, acting on the recommendation of the South African Medical and Dental Council, has made the regulations set out in the Schedule hereto.

### SCHEDULE

A medical practitioner or dentist wishing, under [section 52](#) (2) (b) of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), to dispense medicine in the practice of his profession as contemplated in section 52 (1) (a) of the said Act shall apply in the following manner for registration under section 52:

A written application containing the following particulars of the applicant shall be forwarded to the Registrar:

- (a) Full names;
- (b) registered address;
- (c) registration number;
- (d) identity number;
- (e) places of practice;
- (f) full names of partners (if any).
