APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF TRAINING FACILITIES

We refer to the above-mentioned matter.

It was previously communicated that all previously approved Pathology training laboratories will remain approved to train Medical Technology student and interns until 30 June 2020. Thereafter any Pathology laboratory that had not applied for approval or re-approval; will be deemed unapproved and would not be able to train any professional category of Medical Technology students and interns.

Due to Covid-19 Lockdown Regulation, all evaluations which were scheduled to be conducted in April, May and June 2020 were postponed.

We are pleased to inform you that all previously approved training laboratories which were not yet re-evaluated for training status will retain the training status until 31 December 2020.

It is difficult to predict how long the scourge of the COVID-19 pandemic would last, therefore further extensions if required would be determined by the incoming Board based on the period of the Covid-19 Lockdown Regulations and the activities allowed to be carried out.

The Board would like to thank all the training facilities who have applied for approval of training status during its term office. Together we have managed to clear most of the backlog of evaluations of training laboratories for approval. We would also like to encourage those facilities that have not applied for approval to do so.
