

Scope of Profession - OCC

[Occupational Therapy](#) refers to acts which have as their aim the evaluation, improvement or maintenance of the health, development, functional performance and self-assertion of those in whom these are impaired or at risk, through the prescription and guidance of the patient's or client's participation in normal activities, together with the application of appropriate techniques preceding or during participation in normal activities which facilitate such participation.

[Medical Orthotics](#) is the design and/or the production except components of appliances and/or the fitting and/or the supply of appliances intended to restore the function and/or to compensate for limitations and/or improve the physiological performance of the part of the muscula skeletal system that has lost its function or which has never attained its full functional development or which is subject to congenital abnormalities.

[Medical Prosthetics](#) is the design and/or the production except components of appliances and/or the fitting and/or the supply of appliances intended to replace in whole or in part limbs amputated or deformed congenitally in order to restor.

[Arts Therapy](#) (also called art psychotherapy or analytic art psychotherapy) is a mode of psychotherapy in which creative use of various physical materials to produce images and objects is integral to the therapeutic process. Arts Therapy focuses on the making, manipulation and interpretation by client(s) and therapist of visual images, objects and materials (paintings, drawings, constructions etc.) in the presence of the arts therapist in a safe setting.
