

# HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

## REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION BY PODIATRISTS OF ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

The Minister of Health, on the recommendation of the South African Medical and Dental Council, hereby makes the following regulations in terms of [section 61](#) (1) (o) of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974):

The following qualifications held by podiatrists shall be registrable as additional qualifications under [section 35](#) of the Act:

1. Any qualification recognised by the council in terms of [section 32](#) (1) of the Act and listed in the rules for the registration of podiatrists.
