REGISTERS	REQUIREMENTS FOR RESTORATION
Dental Assistants	<ul> <li>Submission of the following documents:</li> <li>A duly completed application for restoration form (Form 18)</li> <li>Proof of payment of the restoration fees and all other relevant outstanding fees.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All dental Assistants are registered in the category "supervised practice" and have to work under <u>direct</u> supervision at all times and therefore, they are not required to submit confirmation of completion supervised period.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Those who have been off the register for <u>less than two years</u> will be registered in the category in which they were previously registered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Applications from Dental Assistants whose names had been off the relevant register for a period <u>longer than six (6) years</u>, or who have not registered with the HPCSA within six (6) years of obtaining initial qualification, must undergo an assessment at a Board recognised Higher Education Institution. Upon successful completion of the assessment they will be registered in the relevant category in which they were previously registered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Dental Assistants will also be required to accrue the necessary Continuing Education Units (CEU's) after restoration according to the CPD guidelines and will be included in an audit within a year of restoration.</li> </ul>

Dental Therapists	Submission of the following documents:
	i. A duly completed application for restoration form (Form 18)
	ii. Proof of payment of the restoration fees and all other relevant outstanding fees.
	<ul> <li>Those who have been off the register for <u>less than two years</u> will be registered in the category in which they were previously registered.</li> </ul>
	• Those who have been off the register for <b>between two and six years</b> will be registered in the category supervised practice and must practise under the supervision of a Dentist or Dental Therapist (in independent practice) for at least one (1) year prior to being eligible to apply for independent practice status.
	<ul> <li>Applications from Dental Therapists whose names had been off the relevant register for a period <u>longer than six (6) years</u>, or who have not registered with the HPCSA within six</li> </ul>

	(6) years of obtaining initial qualification, must undergo an assessment at a Board recognised Higher Education Institution. Upon successful completion of the assessment they will be registered in the category supervised practice, and must practise under the supervision of a Dentist or Dental Therapist (who is registered in the category independent practice) for at least one (1) year prior to being eligible to apply for independent practice status.
	<ul> <li>Dental Therapists will also be required to accrue the necessary Continuing Education Units (CEU's) after restoration according to the CPD guidelines and will be included in an audit within a year of restoration.</li> </ul>

Oral Hygienists	Submission of the following documents:
	i. A duly completed application for restoration form (Form 18)
	ii. Proof of payment of the restoration fees and all other relevant outstanding fees.
	<ul> <li>Those who have been off the register for <u>less than two years</u> will be registered in the category in which they were previously registered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Those who have been off the register for <u>between two and six years</u> will be registered in the category supervised practice and must practise under the supervision of a Dentist or Dental Therapist/oral Hygienist (in independent practice) for at least one (1) year prior to being eligible to apply for independent practice status.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Applications from Oral Hygienists whose names had been off the relevant register for a period <u>longer than six (6) years</u>, or who have not registered with the HPCSA within six (6) years of obtaining initial qualification, must undergo an assessment at a Board recognised Higher Education Institution. Upon successful completion of the assessment they will be registered in the category supervised practice, and must practise under the supervision of a Dentist or Dental Therapist/Oral Hygienists (who is registered in the category independent practice) for at least one (1) year prior to being eligible to apply for independent practice status.</li> </ul>
	Oral Hygienist's will also be required to accrue the necessary Continuing Education Units (CEU's) after restoration according to the CPD guidelines and will be included in an audit within a year of restoration.
