## PBEHP RESTORATION GUIDELINES/PROCESS

---

The Professional Board for Environmental Health Practitioners (PBEHP) in September 2019 amended the restoration guidelines/process for practitioners who intend on restoring their name to the HPCSA register. It was therefore resolved that the restoration process be as follows:

1. 0 - 2 years off the register: straight restoration (with applicable restoration/penalty fee only)
2. +2 - 4 years off the register: six months supervised practice (with applicable restoration/penalty fee only)
3. +4 years off the register: Board examination (with Board Exam fee and applicable restoration/penalty fee)
