The Health Professions Council of South Africa has, under <u>Section 61A</u> (1) (L) read with <u>Section 35</u> of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), made the rules in the schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

- 1. In these rules "the Act" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No.56 of 1974) and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates:-
 - **"board"** means the Professional Board for Occupational Therapy, Medical Orthotics/Prosthetics and Arts Therapy established under section 15 of the Act;
 - "medical orthotist and prosthetist" means a person registered as such under the Act;
- 3. The following qualifications obtained by Medical Orthotists and Prosthetists shall be registrable as additional qualifications under section 35 of the Act:-
