

HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

RULES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY TECHNICIANS

Published under General Notice 533 in *Government Gazette* 9338 of 27 July 1984.

The South African Medical and Dental Council hereby in terms of [section 32](#) (1) of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), makes the rules contained in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The Council may register as an occupational therapy technician any person -

1. who holds a technical, artistic, or clerical qualification recognised by Council; and
2. who has successfully completed -
 - 2.1 a course recognised by council of at least 50 teaching hours in orientation to occupational therapy, in all spheres of occupational spheres therapy; and
 - 2.2 one year's practical experience subsequent to having obtained the qualification in regulation 1 in a full-time capacity or the equivalent in a part-time capacity in an occupational therapy department approved by Council under the supervision of a registered occupational therapist.
