In terms of <u>section 61(1)(0)</u> of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), the Minister of Health and Welfare, acting on the recommendation of the South African Medical and Dental Council, has made the regulations set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. In this Schedule "the Act" shall mean the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning and, unless the context otherwise indicates

"the regulations" shall mean the regulations published under Government Notice R2313 of 3 December 1976.

2. The regulations are hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
