SCHEDULE

Definitions

- 1. In these rules "the Act" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No.56 of 1974) and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates:-
 - **"board"** means the Professional Board for Physiotherapy, Podiatry and Biokinetics established under section 15 of the Act;
 - "biokineticist" means a person registered as such under the Act.
- 2. The following qualifications obtained by biokineticists in the field of biokinetics, unless otherwise specified, shall be registrable as additional qualifications under <u>section 35</u> of the Act:-
