HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

REGULATIONS RELATING TO NAMES THAT MAY NOT BE USED IN RELATION TO THE PROFESSION OF PSYCHOLOGY

The Minister of Health has, in consultation with the Health Professions Council of South Africa, in terms of section 61(1), read with section 40(c) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), made the regulations in the Schedule.

1.Definitions2.Names that may not be used

1. Definitions

In this Schedule "**the Act**" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act must bear such meaning.

2. Names that may not be used

No person who is not registered in terms of the Act as -

- (a) a psychologist;
- (b) a psychometrist or
- (c) a registered counsellor,

may use that particular appellation or any derivatives thereof.
