The Minister of Health and Welfare, in terms of <u>section 61</u> (1) (0), read with <u>section 61</u> (4), of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), has, on the recommendation of the South African Medical and Dental Council, made the regulations set out in the Schedule hereto.
