

HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

RULES RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION BY SPEECH THERAPISTS, SPEECH THERAPISTS AND AUDIOLOGISTS AND AUDIOLOGISTS OF ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Published under Board Notice 40 in *Government Gazette* 35258 of 20 April 2012.

The Health Professions Council of South Africa has, in terms of [section 61A](#) read with [section 35](#) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), made the rules in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. In these Rules “the Act” means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No.56 of 1974), and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have such meaning and, unless the context otherwise indicates-

“board” means the Professional Board for Speech, Language and Hearing Professions established in terms of [section 15](#) of the Act;

2. The following qualifications held by speech therapists, speech therapist and audiologists, and audiologists shall be registrable as additional qualifications in terms of [section 35](#) of the Act:
