HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 56 OF 1974

RULES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF SPEECH AND HEARING CORRECTIONISTS

Published under General Notice 554 in Government Gazette 9918 of 6 September 1985.

The South African Medical and Dental Council in terms of <u>section 32</u>(1) read with <u>section 61</u>(4) of the Medical, Dental and Supplementary Health Service Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), hereby substitute the rules published under Government Notice R538 of 1984 as amended by Government Notice R 651 of 1984 for the rules as contained in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. The council may register as a speech and hearing correctionist any person who has obtained after examination the following qualification

Examining authority and qualification

Abbreviation for registration

REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

University of Cape Town

Diploma in Specialised Education Dip Spec Ed (S & H) Cape (Handicapped In Speech and Hearing)

Town

The qualification will only be recognised if granted on or before 31 December 1982.

2. Where, in the case of an application for registration, the qualification on which the application is based, has not already been approved by the council, the applicant shall be required to furnish the Professional Board for Speech Therapy and Audiology and the council with authoritative Information as to the training required for such qualification, whereupon, if the standard of such training is considered satisfactory by the council, such qualification may be approved.
